Bio:

Glenn P. Brady, CPA, is an internationally recognized expert on governance, risk management, internal controls, and compliance. Glenn recently retired from his role as a senior partner with PricewaterhouseCoopers after more than 35 years of professional services experience. As a (PwC) partner, he frequently worked with executive management and boards of large, complex organizations to help improve their capabilities to balance growth, risk and return strategies and the execution of business activities.

Brady's most recent role was serving as the Global Managing Partner of PwC's aerospace and defense practice. In this role, he developed, provided, and led the practice's professional services across assurance, tax, and advisory for this dynamic industry that transcended the aerospace, space, shipbuilding, cyber, and MRO sectors. He was also a co-founder of PwC's risk management and internal controls consulting practice, serving in various leadership roles within the U.S. firm over his career. Upon the introduction of the Sarbanes-Oxley Act of 2002, Brady quickly emerged as a thought leader within PwC and the profession as it relates to the development of tools and processes to allow boards and senior executives to efficiently demonstrate standards of care over the maintenance of effective systems of controls over financial reporting.

Prior to his twenty plus years as a PwC partner, Brady began his career in the assurance practice of KPMG, where, after seven years auditing, he left the professional services field to accumulate experiences in industry by serving as controller for divisions of EG&G and MasterCard International. Upon his return to professional services in 1996, Brady moved through the ranks of PwC's risk management and internal controls business and aerospace and defense practice, quite often working at the intersection of those topics within those sectors.

As an expert in internal control and risk management, Brady was a contributing author in the development of the Committee of Sponsoring Organizations of the Treadway Commission (COSO) two landmark reports, "2013 Internal Control – Integrate Framework" and "Enterprise Risk Management – Integrated Framework" recognized as standards for effective internal control and risk management.

Brady was a certified public accountant licensed in the state of Missouri and a member of the AICPA. He is a graduate of Southeast Missouri State University and holds degrees in both accounting and finance. He resides in St. Louis, Missouri, and has been married to his wife Sharon

for thirty plus years. Since his retirement in 2021, he has enjoyed spending time with his family, including his three grown children and his grandchildren.
